

Privacy Policy

1. The Service shall not collect any information in the automatic way, except for information in cookies files. Cookies files are information data, including but not limited to text files, stored in the Service User's end device to use the Service internet sites. Cookies files usually contain the name of the internet site they come from, time of storing them on the end device and the unique number.

2. The operator MCE-MeetLab Sp. z o.o. registered in National Court Register, District court for the Capital City of Warsaw, XIII Commercial Department (Sąd Rejonowy dla [m.st.](#) Warszawy XIII Wydział Gospodarczy), share capital 5000 PLN paid in full, based in Warsaw, Osowskiej 23 m 6, NIP (tax identification number): 1132870945, REGON (statistical number): 146983073, (the „Operator”) is an entity to upload cookies files on the Service User's end device and to get access to them.

3. Cookies files shall be used to:

a) adapt the content of the Service internet sites to User's preferences and to optimize the use of internet sites.; particularly, these files let us recognize the Service User's device and display our internet site properly, as adapted to User's individual needs;

b) produce statistics to let us better understand how the Service Users use our internet sites, which makes us possible to improve their structure and content.

4. There are two types of cookies files used within the Service framework: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files stored on the User's end device until logging out, quitting the internet site or switching off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are kept in the User's end device for the time specified in cookies parameters or until they are deleted by the User.

5. The following types of cookies files are used within the framework of the Service:

a) necessary cookies to enable the use of services in the Service, e.g. authenticating cookies used for services that require authentication within the Service framework;

b) cookies to ensure safety, e.g. used to detect cases of manipulation of authentication within the Service framework;

c) performance cookies to enable collecting information on the method of use the Service internet sites.

6. In many cases, the software to browse internet sites (internet browser) allows by default storage of cookies on the User's end device. The Service Users can change any time their cookies settings. These settings can be changed particularly in such way that they block self-support cookies in internet browser settings or inform any time that they have been uploaded on the User's end device. Detailed information on possibilities and methods of cookies service is available in the software (internet browser) settings.

7. The Service Operator informs that restrictions in use of cookies can affect some of the functionality available at the Service internet sites.

8. Cookies files uploaded on the User's end device can be used also by partners cooperating with the Service Operator.
